During the two previous Road Warrior drives the following problems occurred:

2006

Two cars had fuel pump trouble. One spare did not work. One steel gas line broke during repair.

One fan belt broke.

One windshield wiper was lost.

One engine malfunctioned due to a filthy air filter.

One manifold/exhaust gasket broke.

2007

One car had trouble with a fuel pump, twice.

One car experienced an alternator not charging.

One car had a malfunctioning generator.
